## HOW TO ASSEMBLE BRASS PIPE FITTINGS

## STRAIGHT FITTINGS

- Hand tighten external (male) thread into internal (female) thread.
- Tighten an additional 2 full turns with a wrench for male pipe threads up to 1/2"
- For male pipe theads greater than 1/2" tighten 1-1/2 to 2-1/2 full turns past finger tight.





## **ELBOW OR TEE FITTINGS**

- Hand tighten external (male) thread into internal (female) thread.
- Tighten an additional 1 to 1-1/2 full turns with a wrench.
- Continue tightening the fitting clockwise to align with tubing or other connections. (Never turn counter clockwise)





**NOTE**: Once the assembly has been made, neither end should be backed off (loosened). This minimizes the possibility of a leaking thread joint after assembly.
